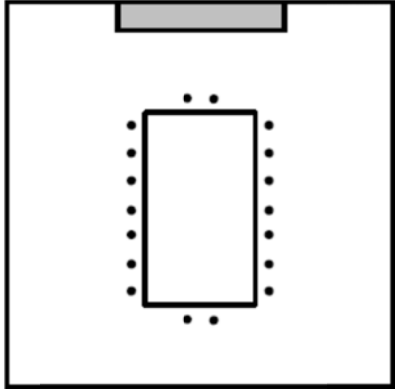


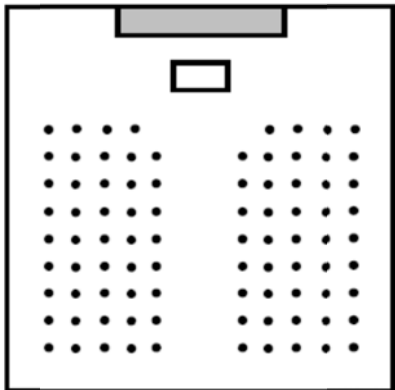
U-Shape

- Seating around three sides of the room – good for presentations from front
- Square layout conducive to discussion
- Presentation space in the middle of the room



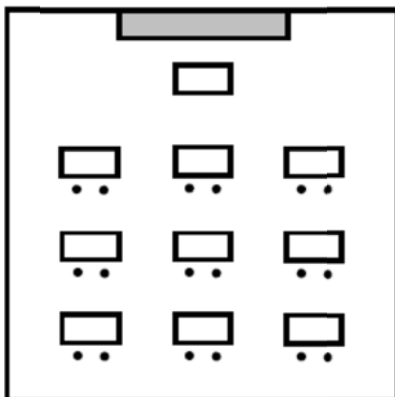
Boardroom Style

- Centrally located table
- Classic layout ideal for debate and discussion
- Popular for smaller meetings



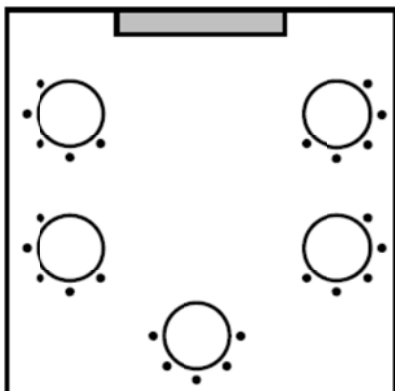
Theatre Style

- Used for product launches, presentations, displays
- Used to present to large numbers of delegates
- Allows for optimal room occupancy



Classroom Style

- Used to present to small to medium groups
- Delegates (in ones or twos) have own workspace
- Ideal for testing or individual training



Cabaret Style

- All delegate front-centre on round tables
- Large space in middle of room
- Ideal for small group work and discussion
